Spectators, Parents and Carers



I WILL

- Make myself aware of the club's policies and procedures (<u>link</u>)
- Not post match results on social media, or engage in public discussion of results, until team reaches competitive football (U12 onwards)
- Not photograph or video any player, or post images containing another child on social media, unless permitted by relevant parent/guardian
- Report any incidents of concern directly to the Clubs Welfare Officer (<u>safeguarding@vulcanjuniorsfc.co.uk</u>)
- Applaud effort and good play to both playing teams.
- Always respect the match officials' and coaches decisions and encourage your child to do the same
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area
- Not smoke or use an e-cigarette on the sideline.
- Not approach another Vulcan FC coach with the prospect of my child moving to their team unless discussed with my current coach

IF I DON'T I MAY BE

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Obliged to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents
- Required to pay any FA/League fines, or serve suspension, imposed due to breaches in conduct.
